Cape Lambert is one of the sea ports for exporting iron ore from Rio Tinto's mining operations in the Pilbara. Cape Lambert is East of Karratha (59 km), West of Port Hedland (220 km).

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Cape Lambert Port B project comprises the construction of a new port facility to the existing Cape Lambert Port facility. This involved construction of train unloading infrastructure, stockyard and new ship loading facilities (including a new wharf).

SCOPE OF WORK

Modification and expansion works associated with miscellaneous work at the Cape Lambert facility. Work included project management, supervision, execution, commissioning, and shutdown planning for stacker reclaimer repairs, conveyor modifications, pump change outs and refurbishments, etc.

Tempo's project team, inclusive of project management, supervision, HSE, QA management, welding test facility trainers, and front line workers peaked to approximately a hundred and eighty (180) full time equivalents.
